Pond Committee

Did You Know? The Pond Committee reminds all homeowners that whatever is in the streets goes down the



storm drains and directly into our lagoons before being released to the Okatie River. Please remove leaves, pine straw, and yard debris from the road and gutters before it enters our lagoons and waterways. This will help keep our lagoons healthy and possibly reduce the need for any preventable future remediation

Security & Safety Committee

There are some residents whose RFID tags are consistently not being read by the reader and require the guard to open the gate via remote control. If the blue light on the RFID reader does not turn green by the time your car reaches the reader, it means your tag has not been read. This can be caused



by a number of issues including tag damage (weather, car washes, etc.) and tag placement. The reader has been tested and is working well. If you have any issues with your RFID tag not being read, please contact IMC (843-785-4775 Ext. 201) to obtain a new tag and be sure to follow the directions carefully regarding tag placement on your windshield.

Remember our speed limit is **20 MPH**. Be watchful for kids at the bus stops and riding bikes/walking to school.

NEW GROUP FOR BAYNARD PARK -Historical Fiction BOOK CLUB


