
If you are experiencing any issues with your RFID tag not being read, please contact IMC (843-785-4775 Ext. 201) to obtain a new tag.



**It's official!!** The Speed Limit in Baynard Park is 20MPH. New signs were recently posted to remind all drivers. Please obey our 20 MPH speed limit at all times and be watchful for kids playing.

Bluffton Police Department will now begin patrolling our streets and will not only be watching for Speed and Stop Sign violations but also Golf Cart Registrations and Driver licensing. Golf Cart Owners please take time to review Section 10.3 in the BP Rules & Regulations regarding Golf Carts.

The broken stormwater pipe, Pond #7 (between Rosewood Lane and Bainbridge Way), repair was completed on Monday, 12/05 - See photos.







The next phase, after contract approval, for Pond #7 will be to build a retaining wall near this repair to minimize the bog area of water-logged soil and unwanted vegetation.

The Pond Committee is evaluating contracts for the easement repairs for Ponds, #3, #6, #9 and #10. We expect this work to be started early 2023.






Volunteers are needed for the decorations committee. The committee is responsible for the wreath placements and scheduling the holiday lights be hung in December. We need a committee and a head of committee.
