

To The Baynard Park Community

Baynard Park neighbors, do you know how lucky we are to live in this great BP community? Let me share my story with you that brings me to this

conclusion.

Some two years ago I was diagnosed with stage three kidney failure due to an auto-immune disease called ANCA which I never knew I had. Shortly after diagnosis I was hospitalized to undergo infusions to reduce the swelling in the arteries to my kidneys. From that first day of diagnosis this community has wrapped their arms around me with warm wishes, love, kind words and support. It was a rough 15 months of waiting on the kidney list, but on January 9th of this year I received a living donor kidney at MUSC in Charleston. I was a part of an 8-person swap chain where we all had surgery within two days of each other at MUSC. The outpouring of support, the dinner train, sweets, balloons, cards, gifts of joy, people caring for my mom, and wishes from BP residents I've yet to meet made this experience so much less overwhelming.

God had a plan when he guided us here to Baynard, so yes, we are blessed to live in such a wonderful community. You don't even have to ask, good just comes your way.

We will be forever thankful.

If you've ever thought of being a living donor, reach out to me. I've learned so much. And after all, we all only need one kidney.


