Landscaping Update

As you know, in January we had a landscape architect come and design the front entrance, flagpole and guardhouse areas. The plantings of many suggested plantings took place in January with a guarantee of being replaced should anything happen to them. As you can clearly see, frost did happen and we lost many shrubs. Added to this the flagpole plantings were never completed and we are still awaiting the spring rotation of annuals.

We are currently in legal proceedings with the company hired, as he is not honoring his contract. We are looking into another company to complete and modify the job and maintain all florals on a weekly basis. We appreciate your patience and realize this is unsightly but we are trying to remediate as quickly as possible. Thank you!

HYDRANGEAS GARDENING TIPS

Spring is almost here! You should begin to see some life in your Hydrangeas. Here's some care notes for the coming month.

Foliage growth on garden hydrangeas (*Hydrangea macrophylla*) is commencing. Wait a few weeks after leaf out and prune out any dead wood. There may be dead wood in the canopy from the January cold weather.

Fertilize soon with a slow-release ornamental / landscape fertilizer - Osmocote, Fertilome Gardener's Special, Fertilome Tree and Shrub Food, etc.

Do not do a height reduction pruning on these - on most garden hydrangeas flower buds for this year were set last year (late summer, fall). If you have dead wood, remove.

Some garden hydrangeas - such as the Endless Summer varieties that bloom on new wood - will likely bloom this year with good late winter, early spring care.

REMINDER

Baynard Park is proud to be pet-friendly, and we're happy your four-legged family members are part of our community, but recently we've had some complaints.

Of course, like any good neighbor, it's important that these pets don't create an unpleasant environment for everyone else. To avoid unnecessary disputes and potential rule violations, here are some guidelines residents should follow to ensure their furry friends continue to be a welcome addition to the neighborhood.

Remember, pets must be leashed at all times when outside of your home. Not only is this a community rule, it's the law as well! Recurring concerns with off-leash dogs should be reported to IMC and/or Beaufort County Animal Services at (843) 255-5010

Pet waste must be cleaned up, again, it's the law! No one wants to see, smell or accidentally step in the "gift" your dog left on the grassy common area or neighbors' lawns. So, when your dog needs to go, be sure to properly dispose of it. Not only will this keep the community looking better, but it will help keep groundwater clean and help prevent the spread of fecal-borne diseases. ***Please utilize the pet waste stations located throughout our community.***

Please also be cognizant of your dog kicking mulch, sod or other areas. If this occurs, please try to remediate the area back to its original state.
