
News from the Board

FROM THE ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (ARC)

Removing and replacing dead plants is routine maintenance and does not require permission from the ARC. If a homeowner is increasing the size of the beds, ARC approval is necessary. See the Rules, Regulations, and Design Guidelines, Section 24 for additional information.

See 24.2.1 Planting Beds

Planting beds cannot be expanded or new beds added without approval by the Architectural Review Committee.

See 24.2.2 Plantings

All plantings and landscaping shall be maintained to present a neat appearance with no overgrowth. Plantings may be suspended, placed on pedestals or placed in decorative containers. Refer to Exhibit F - LANDSCAPE ACCESSORY GUIDE for information on plant containers. When plant items that were previously approved are to be changed to similar items and are in compliance with the Design Guidelines, reapplication is not required.

24.2.9 Removal of Existing Plants/Trees

Dead or terminally diseased plants/trees shall be promptly removed.

Note: All of the Baynard Park Residential Design Rules and Guidelines are available on baynardpark.org under Governing Documents / RR & Design Guide. The Residential Design Rules and Guidelines begins in Section 19 and continues through Section 32 and is followed by a series of Exhibits that provide additional information. This is where you can find what modifications require you to submit an application for approval from of the ARC, as well as other Design Rules and Guidelines.

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT





PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT: on Behalf of Hummingbirds:

This hummingbird is unable to retract her tongue due to fungal spores that have germinated on her tongue or in her gullet caused by folks mixing honey or anything other than white cane sugar with water. She will die because she can no longer feed.

If you have feeders, PLEASE USE ONLY WHITE CANE SUGAR in your mixture of 1 part sugar to 4 parts water. No organic or raw or brown sugar, no powdered sugar, no honey, no artificial sugar. Use white CANE sugar/water mixture which is most similar to actual flower nectar. And no toxic red color liquids such as koolaid etc..!

Change the sugar water mixture every couple of days, especially during high temperatures, as it will start to ferment if it sits out for days on end. If you can't or won't do this, please do not put out a feeder at all.
